**HARRY BUNCE HAS CARVED OUT A [UNIQUE POSITION](#) IN THE ART WORLD WITH HIS CAST OF CUTE, BUT NOT ALWAYS CUDDLY, CREATURES.**

His quirky and distinctive paintings and sculptures of rabbits and cats defy categorisation, combining illustration, street art and fine art with a biting sense of humour.

After a brief and volatile spell at Art School, Harry studied Fashion and Textiles at Bristol and spent two decades working in fashion before returning to art and making it his career. He gained a loyal following in Bristol, and then a chance collaboration with screen printing gurus, Screen One, who also worked with Banksy and Nick Walker, introduced a more graphic element to his style, sharpening its unique, slightly unnerving edge and widening his audience.

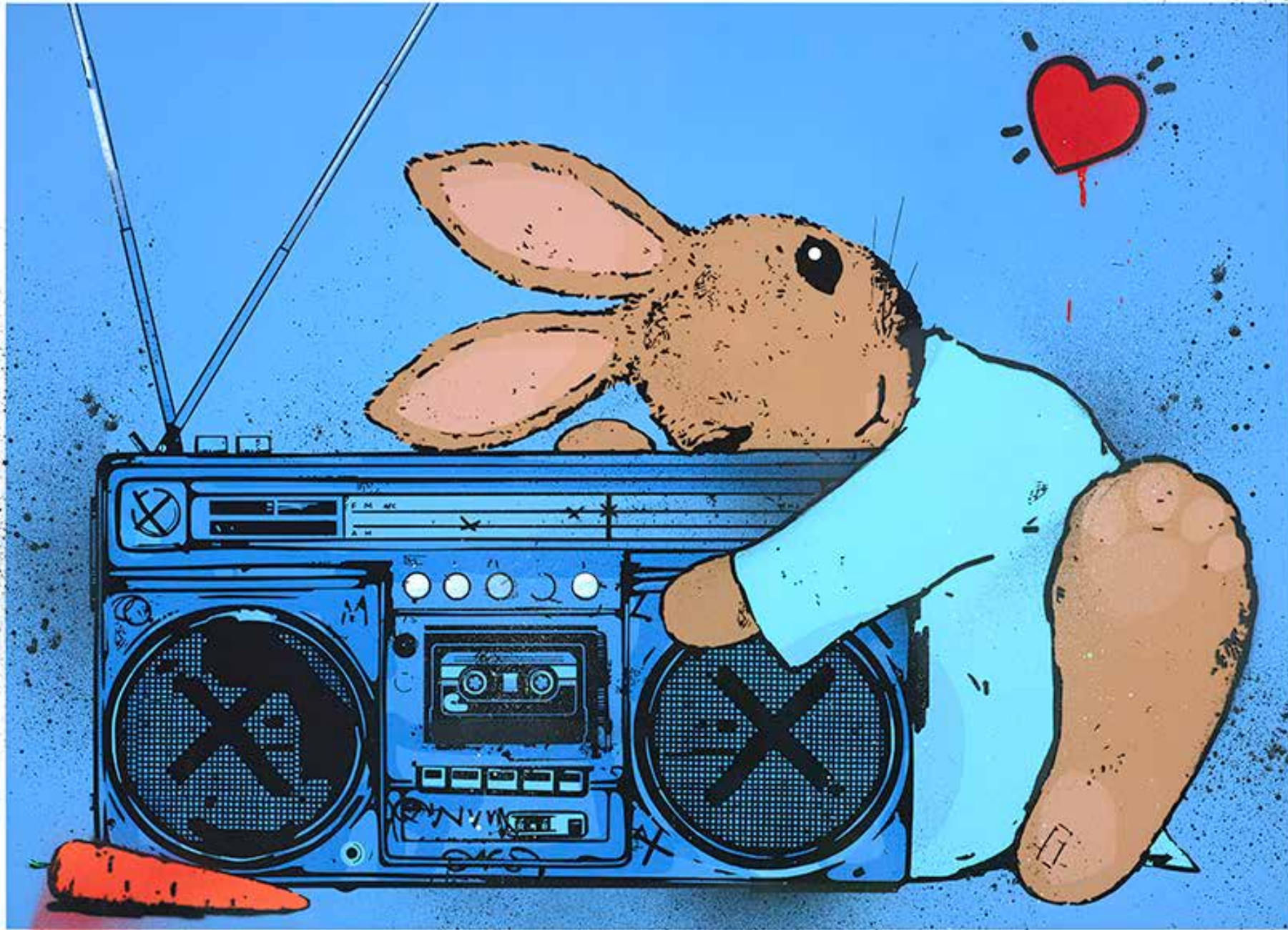
